TODAY'S READINGS**First Reading: Wisdom 6:12-16**

Regarded as personifying God's power, Wisdom is readily and easily found by those who seek her.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

The Thessalonians, who fear that those who have died will miss Christ's return, are comforted by Paul's assurance that those "who have died in Christ will rise first."

Gospel: Matthew 25:1-13

In the parable of the five sensible bridesmaids and the five foolish bridesmaids, Jesus emphasizes the fact that we must always be ready for the coming of Christ because in his words, "You know not the day or the hour."

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

"Go instead to the merchants and buy some oil for yourselves.' While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came and those who were ready went into the wedding feast with him. Then the doors were locked. Afterwards the others came and said, 'Lord, Lord, open the door for us.' But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.' Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour."

How often we hear the expression 'this is a wakeup call.' It might call us to study harder, begin a healthier life style, or even to express gratitude for escaping an accident or tragedy.

The parable of Jesus, who many have read this year, is directed to me today. How ready and prepared am I to accompany the Lord, who is walking with me today. The lamp oil is God's grace. Is it burning in me, at this moment? If the battery is low, where can I have it recharged? God's grace we find in the sacraments.

How often we have been offered the example of a door, as opening the door of our hearts to the Lord, or He Himself knocking at the door wanting to enter. He is the gatekeeper. A door allows entrance to another place.

Don't put off applying the parallel to your own spiritual life. It is my wakeup call.

LECTURAS DE HOY**Primera Lectura: Sabiduría 6:12-16**

Evangelio: San Mateo 25:1-13

En esta parábola de las cinco muchachas previsoras y de las cinco despreocupadas, Jesús enfatiza el hecho de que debemos estar siempre alertas para la venida de Cristo, pues, en sus palabras: "porque no saben ni el día ni la hora."

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

"Es mejor que vayan a comprarlo al mercado'. Mientras tanto, llegó el esposo: las que estaban preparadas entraron con él en la sala nupcial y se cerró la puerta. Después llegaron las otras jóvenes y dijeron: 'Señor, señor, ábrenos', pero él respondió: 'Les aseguro que no las conozco'. Estén prevenidos, porque no saben el día ni la hora.'

A menudo escuchamos la expresión: 'Es una llamada de atención.' Puede que nos llame a estudiar más duro, cambiar nuestro estilo de vida, o a expresar gratitud por escapar de un accidente o tragedia.

La parábola de Jesús, de las cuales hemos leído muchas este año, está dirigida a mí. ¿Qué tan listo y preparado estoy para acompañar al Señor, quien camina junto a mí hoy? La lámpara de aceite es la gracia de Dios. ¿Arde en mí en este momento? Si las baterías están bajas, dónde puedo recargarlas? Encontramos la gracia de Dios en los sacramentos.

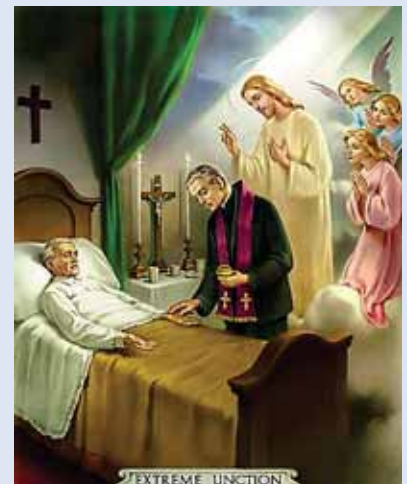

Catechesis for This Week / Categeusis Por Esta Semana

THE UNITY AND TRINITY OF GOD / LA UNIDAD Y LA TRINIDAD DE DIOS

from the *Baltimore Catechism* / del *Catecismo de Baltimore*

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth ..." / "Creo en Dios, Padre Todopoderoso, Creador del cielo y de la tierra ..."



Is there only one God?

Yes, there is only one God.

I am the Lord, and there is none else: there is no God besides me. (Isaiah 45:5)

How many Persons are there in God?

In God there are three Divine Persons – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

Going, therefore, teach ye all nations; baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost. (Matthew 28:19)

Is the Father God?

The Father is God and the first Person of the Blessed Trinity.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (I Corinthians 1:3)

Is the Son God?

The Son is God and the second Person of the Blessed Trinity.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1)

Is the Holy Ghost God?

The Holy Ghost is God and the third Person of the Blessed Trinity.

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? (I Corinthians 3:16)

What do we mean by the Blessed Trinity?

By the Blessed Trinity we mean, one and the same God in three Divine Persons.

Going, therefore, teach ye all nations; baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost. (Matthew 28:19)

Are the three Divine Persons really distinct from one another?

The three Divine Persons are really distinct from one another.

And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape, as a dove, upon him. And a voice came from heaven: "Thou art my beloved Son. In thee I am well pleased." (Luke 3:22)

Are the three Divine Persons perfectly equal to one another?

The three Divine Persons are perfectly equal to one another, because all are one and the same God.

I and the Father are one. (John 10:30)

¿Hay un solo Dios?

Sí, solo hay un Dios.

¿Cuántas personas hay en Dios?

¿Es el padre Dios?

Bendito sea el Dios y Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. (I Corintios 1: 3)

¿Es el Hijo Dios?

El Hijo es Dios y la segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad.

En el principio era la Palabra, y la Palabra estaba con Dios, y la Palabra era Dios. (Juan 1: 1)

¿Es el Espíritu Santo Dios?

El Espíritu Santo es Dios y la tercera Persona de la Santísima Trinidad.

¿No sabes que eres el templo de Dios y que el Espíritu de Dios mora en ti? (I Corintios 3:16)

¿Qué queremos decir con la Santísima Trinidad?

Por la Santísima Trinidad queremos decir, uno y el mismo Dios en tres Personas Divinas.

Por lo tanto, yendo, enséñales a todas las naciones; bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. (Mateo 28:19)

¿Son las tres Personas Divinas realmente distintas entre sí?

Las tres Personas Divinas son realmente distintas entre sí.

Y el Espíritu Santo descendió en forma corporal, como una paloma, sobre él. Y vino una voz del cielo: "Tú eres mi Hijo amado. En ti estoy complacido". (Lucas 3:22)

¿Son las tres Personas Divinas perfectamente iguales entre sí?

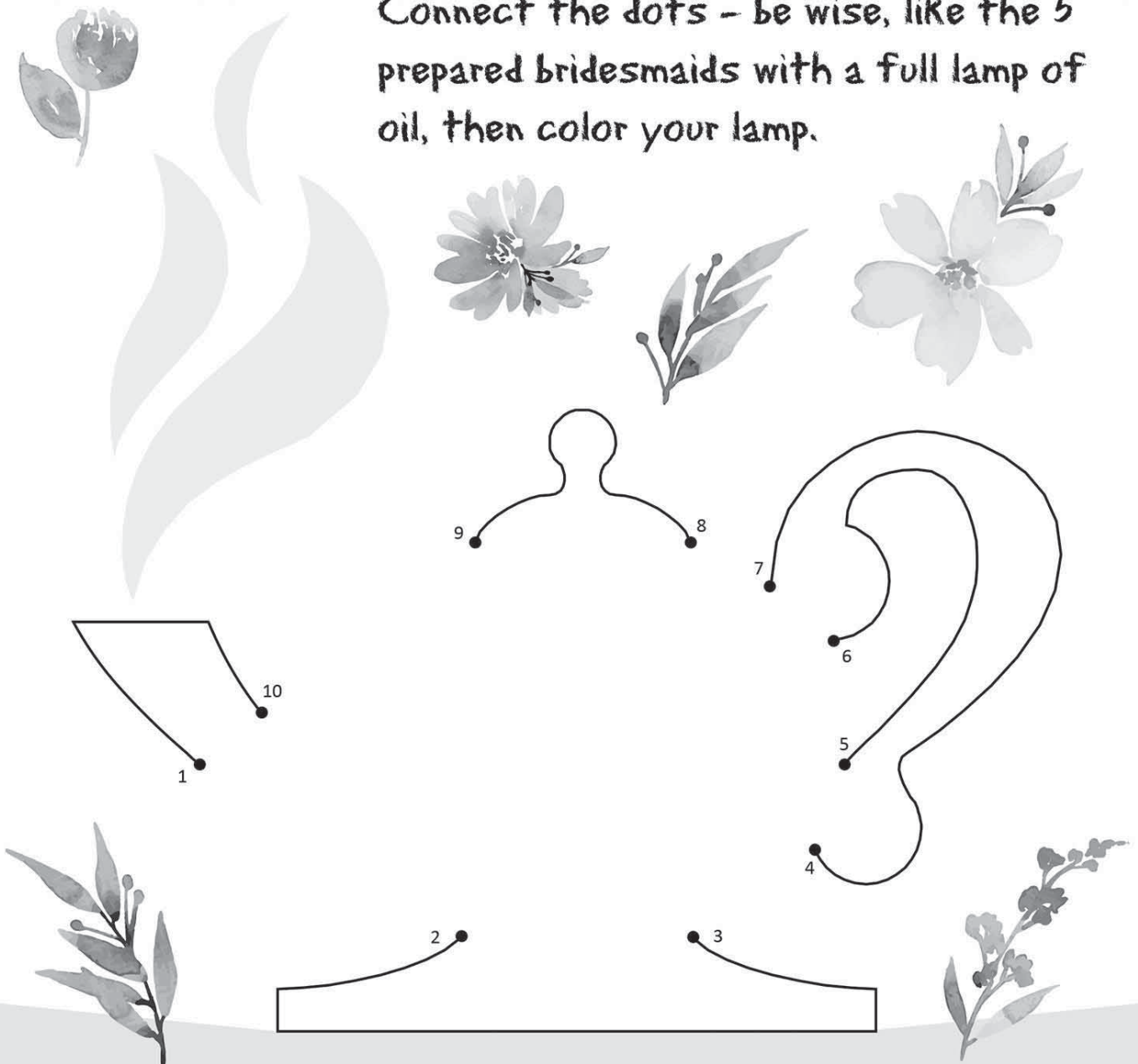
Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time | Matthew 25:1-13
