TODAY'S READINGS**First Reading: Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31**

An encomium for a good and worthy wife, this passage from Proverbs extols all the virtues which a worthy wife possesses – fidelity, industriousness, skill, charity to the poor, and fear of the Lord.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6

Once again, Paul reassures the Thessalonians, who are anxious about the coming of Christ, that they need not fear being unprepared because they are “children of light.”

Gospel: Matthew 25:14-30

Jesus narrates the parable of the talents – in the story, the silver pieces given to the three men. Two of the men invest their coins and double their worth, but the third buries his coins in the ground and earns no return. The message of Jesus is that we must use to the fullest the talents we have received.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

“When one finds a worthy wife, her value is far beyond pearls. Her husband, entrusting his heart to her has an unfailing prize. She brings him good and not evil all the days of her life... She reaches out her hands to the poor, and extends her arms to the needy.”

The teaching of the book of Proverbs is both profound and practical. It opens our eyes to appreciate the gifts we already possess, and often overlook.

We are reminded that the fundamental message of Jesus is love, and its expression is found in respect. When we work to make both part of our lived experience at home, with others, or even in a quiet moment of appreciation, then we begin to appreciate once again, how special we are with a good wife, a loving husband, faithful friends.

Unfortunately, we sometimes fail to recognize how important it is to improve our family life, to work at it as a primary goal, so that God's peace, presence and happiness are found behind our front door. They become a driving force in our lives. Now is the time to begin.

Is Christ part of our lived experience? Is prayer something I bring to my family on a daily basis? Do I reflect joy, ask for forgiveness, and show my concern and interest in what my children are doing?

I recall a picture hanging in a home with the face of Christ. Beneath it was written, ‘Christ is the head of this house, the guest who becomes our host at every meal, the silent listener to every conversation.’ Is this my experience? May we appreciate what Proverbs teaches us today.

LECTURAS DE HOY**Primera Lectura: Proverbios: 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31**

Una vez más, Pablo tranquiliza a los tesalonicenses, quienes están preocupados por la venida de Cristo, diciéndoles que no deben temer estar mal preparados ya que “todos ustedes son de la luz”.

Evangelio: San Mateo 25:14-30

Jesús narra la parábola de los talentos: en la historia éstos son las monedas de plata dadas a tres hombres. Dos de ellos invierten las monedas y doblan el valor, pero el tercero enterra sus monedas en la tierra y no gana nada. Este mensaje de Jesús significa que debemos usar de lleno los talentos que hemos recibido.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

“Una mujer hacendosa, ¿quién la hallará? Vale mucho más que las perlas. Su marido se fia de ella, y no le faltan riquezas. Le trae ganancias y no pérdidas todos los días de su vida... Abre sus manos al necesitado y extiende el brazo al pobre.”

La enseñanza del libro de Proverbios es profunda y práctica. Abre nuestros ojos para apreciar los dones que ya poseemos y que a menudo no notamos.

Se nos recuerda que el mensaje fundamental de Jesús es el amor y que su expresión está fundada en el respeto. Cuando trabajamos para hacer esto parte de nuestro hogar, con otras personas, o cuando tranquilamente reflexionamos, entonces comenzamos a apreciar de nuevo cuán afortunados somos de tener una buena esposa, un esposo amoroso, amigos leales.

Desafortunadamente, a veces fallamos en darnos cuenta cuán importante es mejorar nuestra vida familiar, trabajar en ella como meta principal, para que la paz de Dios, su presencia y alegría se encuentren dentro de nuestro hogar. Se convierten en una fuerza que impulsa nuestras vidas. Ahora es el momento de empezar.

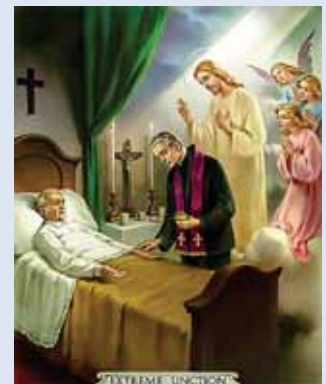

THE UNITY AND TRINITY OF GOD / LA UNIDAD Y LA TRINIDAD DE DIOS

from the *Baltimore Catechism* / del *Catecismo de Baltimore*

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth ...!" / "Creo en Dios, Padre Todopoderoso, Creador del cielo y de la tierra ..."

How are the three Divine Persons, though really distinct from one another, one and the same God?

The three Divine Persons, though really distinct from one another, are one and the same God because all have one and the same Divine nature.

Can we fully understand how the three Divine Persons, though really distinct from one another, are one and the same God?

We cannot fully understand how the three Divine Persons, though really distinct from one another, are one and the same God because this is a supernatural mystery.

What is a supernatural mystery?

A supernatural mystery is a truth which we cannot fully understand, but which we firmly believe because we have God's word for it.

What do we mean when we say that God is the Creator of heaven and earth?

When we say that God is the Creator of heaven and earth we mean that He made all things from nothing by His almighty power.

I am the Lord God, that make all things, that alone stretch out the heavens, that establish the earth. (Isaiah 44:24)

Which are the chief creatures of God?

The chief creatures of God are angels and men.

Thou hast made him a little less than the angels; thou hast crowned him with glory and honor; and thou hast set him over the works of thy hands. (Psalm 8:6-7)

What are angels?

Angels are created spirits, without bodies, having understanding and free will.

Thousands and thousands ministered to him, and ten thousand times a hundred thousand stood before him. (Daniel 7:10)

What gifts did God bestow on the angels when He created them?

When God created the angels, He bestowed on them great wisdom, power, and holiness.

O ye angels of the Lord, bless the Lord. (Daniel 3:58)

Did all the angels remain faithful to God?

Not all the angels remained faithful to God; some of them sinned.

And there was a battle in heaven; Michael and his angels battled with the dragon, and the dragon fought and his angels. And they did not prevail, neither was their place found any more in heaven. (Apocalypse 12:7)

What happened to the angels who remained faithful to God?

The angels who remained faithful to God entered into the eternal happiness of heaven, and these are called good angels.

See that you do not despise one of these little ones; for I tell you, their angels in heaven always behold the face of my Father in heaven. (Matthew 18:10)

¿Cuáles son las principales criaturas de Dios?
